ArtsBridge is an arts education and outreach program of the Jordan Schnitzer Museum of Art, a satellite program for ArtsBridge America.

ArtsBridge provides stipends to qualified University of Oregon students, graduate and undergraduate, to conduct arts workshops in visual art, dance, drama and music to the Lane County community.

ArtsBridge scholars go into county K-12 schools to teach classes with a supervising teacher or lead after-school clubs. ArtsBridge scholars also work with pediatrics patients and non-profit youth organizations.

ArtsBridge creates university-school partnerships that offer university students and schoolteachers the oportunity to devise and implement lessons that integrate the arts into the traditional K-12 curricula in ways that address both specific classroom needs and state and national standards.

Under the guidance of a university faculty mentor, the scholar works with the host teacher to integrate arts instruction within the core curriculum, so that the arts reinforce and enhance lessons in language arts, mathematics, social studies, or science. This support can awaken an appreciation for the value of the arts in education.
