- iOS Apple's proprietary mobile operating system for iPhones and iPads
- **Android** Google's mobile operating system used on mobile devices from multiple manufacturers including Samsung, Sony, LG, Nvidia, Amazon, and many others.
- **Workflow** an automation application that runs on Apple devices (iPhones and iPads); more generally, a workflow describes a sequence of processes through which work passes from start to finish.
- **Variable** As used in programming, a variable is a storage "container" where a program or script stores data, called a value (such as a file, some text, or an image) for later use in the program or script.
- **Automation** techniques for using computers to complete a pre-defined process to reduce steps or actions on the part of the user.
