Add at least two References onto the Blog with ~70 words of description for each one.

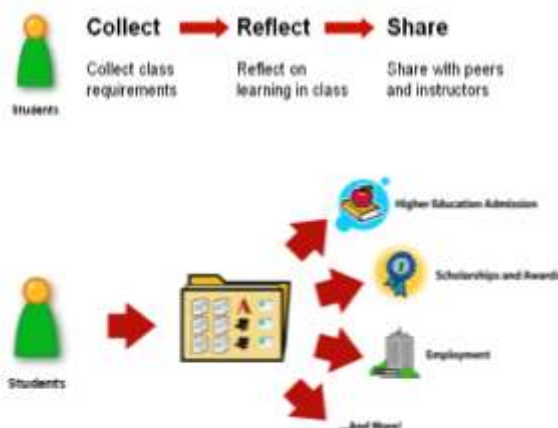
