Dr. Mor is Dean of the Humanities at the University of Haifa and a specialist in Jewish history and culture. He will provide historical context for understanding the Arab-Israeli conflict and share his reflections on the current social climate in Israel. His presentation will be followed by conversation and discussion on the the roots of the Israeli-Palestinian problem, the characteristics of political and social justice, and the transformation of communities marked by violence into those grounded in peace.
