Paper Guidelines

- 1. Any topic on any controversy related to nutrition, If controversy from text, *ch* 10-15, rather than *ch* 1-9
- 2. <u>6 pages</u>, double-sided, double-spaced, ≥ 10 point, simple font (e.g., Arial, Cambri, Times, Universal)
- 3. Include Headers Introduction, topic Headers, Directions for Future Research, Summary & Conclusions, References
- 4. <u>1 page of references</u> (so total = 7 pages), 8 point OK
 ≥ 10 references of which < 5 web-based (.edu,.org,.gov)
- 5. <u>Top resources</u> Science Library + (see S&W pp 19-20 & 26)
