- Prevention Center: Parenting Among Women who are Opioid Users (NIDA-funded Center of Excellence grant). Opportunities for science communication and assisting with pilot studies
- ECHO (Early Growth and Development Study Pediatric Cohort (NIH Office of the Director Collaborative research project). Opportunities to examine children's positive health, neurodevelopment, and obesity using an adoption-sibling cohort
- Early Growth and Development Study (EGDS) – Adolescence (NIDA-funded research grant). Opportunities to study prenatal, genetic, hormonal, and environmental influences on risk for early adolescence substance use
- Scaling Up Testing for SARS-CoV2 in Latinx Communities (NIH Office of the Director-funded collaborative supplement). Opportunities for working with Latinx communities in Oregon to help address barriers to testing for the virus.
- Turning Points (NIJ research project). Opportunities to participate in questionnaire and biomarker research data collection in a study of women who were formerly involved in the juvenile justice and foster care systems.

## Data Available from Completed Research Projects

- Paths 2 the Future: Testing the Efficacy of a Career Development Intervention for High School Girls with Disabilities (IES-funded). Intervention study of high school young women with disabilities.
- Early Growth and Development Study (EGDS) (NICHD and NIDA-funded). Study of children adopted at birth and followed from infancy to early adolescence.

- Siblings Reared Apart: A Naturalistic Cross-Fostering Study of Young Children (NIDA-funded). Study of siblings who were reared apart, each studied when they were in first grade.
- Girls Longitudinal Study (GLO) (NIMH- and NIDA-funded). Intervention study of young women in the juvenile justice system, who were court-mandated to out of home care and followed for 10 years.
- Safe, Healthy, Adolescent Relationships and Peers (SHARP) (NIDA-funded). Intervention study of risk and protective factors related to drug use and sexual risk behavior in females age 13 – 18 who were receiving social services.
- Middle School Success (NIMH- and NIDA-funded). Intervention study of girls in foster care, followed from just prior to entry to middle school for 3 years.
