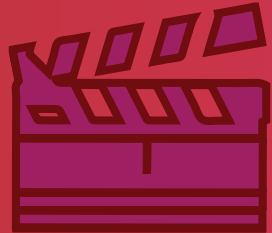


# Art Tech High School - A Day in the Life



After she gives notes to her actors, they film the next run through to show their teacher. They then sample music tracks and Naomi uses her laptop to put them into the film.

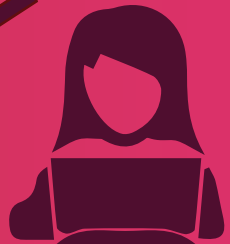
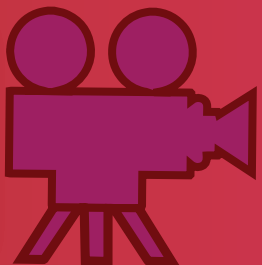


The bell rings to end school, but Naomi heads to dance rehearsal. Video projection technology lets the students project dancer's marks on the stage, helping her learn the choreography.

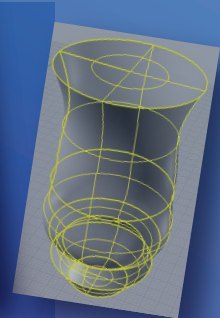
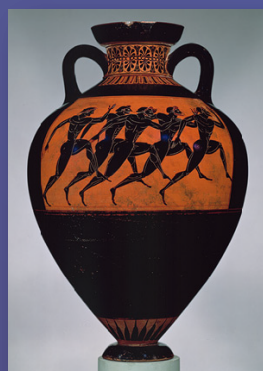
Back at home, Naomi use her computer to create a video scrapbook of Lena Horne for her theater class.
