Component	Questions	Student Response
Topic	<p>What is the story you want to tell about your topic?</p> <p>What do you know about this story and what do you want to learn? (Complete the “K” and “W” sections of a KWL chart.)</p> <p>How will you organize information that you gather? (Examples, notebook with tabs, electronic document)</p>	
Purpose	<p>What is the purpose of your project?</p> <p>Why is this project important?</p>	
Perspective	<p>Whose perspectives will be represented in this project?</p>	
Audience	<p>Who is the intended audience?</p>	
Design	<p>What design modes will you use?</p> <p>What resources will you need?</p> <p>How will your project be shared with others?</p>	
Cross-Cultural Understanding	<p>How does this project contribute to cross-cultural understanding?</p>	
Reflection	<p>What is your perspective on this project?</p>
