Lewis and Clark Road Sign Symbol

This symbol is found along Lewis and Clark Trail highways and on signs that interpret (tell about) sites along the trail. It was the official symbol of the Lewis and Clark Trail Commission, a group of people who identified and planned for the Trail from 1964 to 1969. It then became the official property of the U.S. Department of Interior.
