Posters and Short Oral Paper Presentations

Submission Deadline: May 15th, 2017

The Environmental Studies Program at the University of Oregon is delighted to be hosting the 23th annual JCC. We look forward to organizing a stimulating conference.

The JCC has traditionally been a forum for environmental scholars from Oregon, Oregon State and Portland State Universities to share their research and writing. To encourage interaction and engagement between participants, we are offering the opportunity for students to choose one of several presentation formats, as follows.

Description of presentation formats:

- **Paper presentations** are 10 minutes each (oral presentations), followed by 5 minutes for questions and discussion.
- **Posters** are ideal for presenting work that can be communicated effectively by the use of visuals. As a rule, the amount of text on posters should be minimal. Posters will be displayed at the poster session and may or may not be accompanied by a brief oral presentation.

Students should submit an abstract and indicate whether they prefer a paper presentations or poster. Due to limited time slots, some students may be offered to submit a poster in place of an oral presentation.

Our hope is that these options will encourage and enable more students to participate and present their work, as well as offer more opportunities for cross-campus dialogue and engagement within the Environmental Studies, Sciences, and Management communities.
