

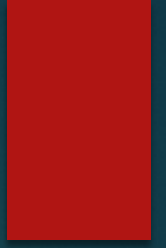

Who cares?

If you are successful, what difference will it make?

How much will it cost?

How long will it take?

What are the midterm and final "exams" to check for success?

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
