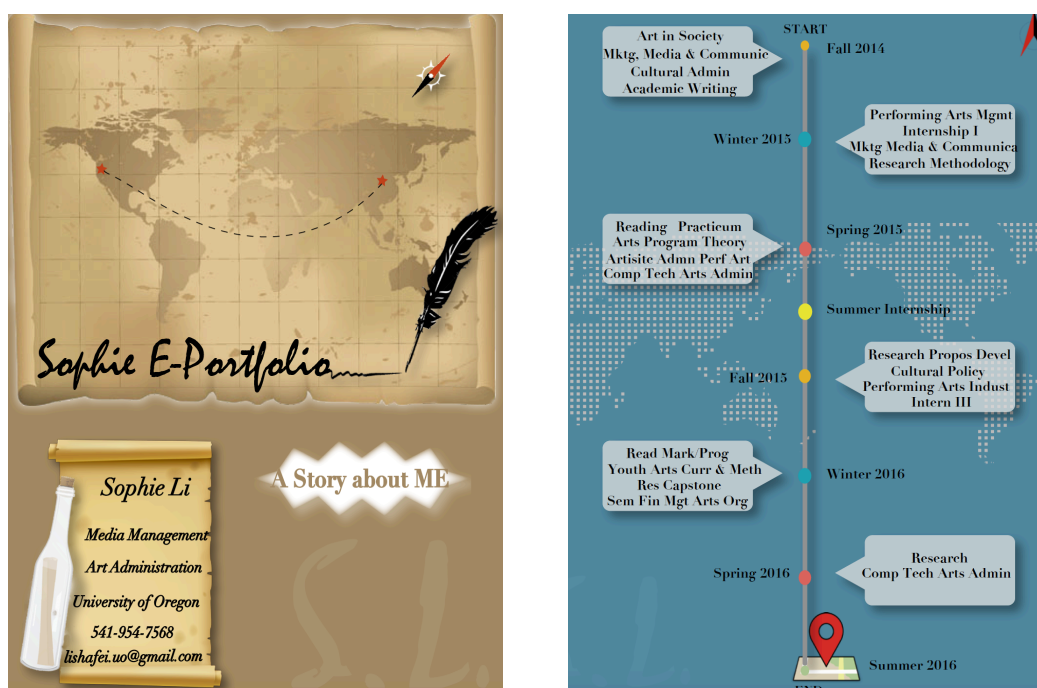


Comparative Technology Weekly Journal Week 6- Week 10
