Motion from the Undergraduate Committee

The Undergraduate Committee herewith notifies the faculty of the motion to consider the following approval from the Theory Area: BA Music Theory concentration program revision

Rationale

The main goal of the proposed revisions is to significantly reduce the number of credits in this degree (from over 100 to under 80). We have had very few students opt for this degree in the past ten years, in large part because it is quite credit-heavy and therefore especially time-consuming. We anticipate that the revised version of the degree will be much more attractive to students with a strong interest in the degree. A second goal is simply to provide more flexibility, so that students (in consultation with faculty) can select the courses that suit their needs best. We have significantly revised our graduate and undergraduate curriculum over the past few years to ensure that students are provided a wider variety of analytical approaches and repertoires to choose from, and that they are given the freedom to do that. We undertook this degree revision in that same spirit.
