To that end, we are administering two awards that will partially fund travel to one or more scientific conferences (could be virtual) where the student is to give a presentation (talk or poster) about their research. The award is \$1000. In order to be eligible you should be a University of Oregon graduate student, member of UOWGS, and be presenting at a conference between June 1st of the current year and May 31st of the following year.

Your complete application must contain the following:

- Application via Google form (link below).
- Brief essay (approximately 500 words) detailing the conference you will attend and how it will help further your career goals (submitted in the Google form as a PDF).
- Short recommendation form completed by your advisor and sent in via their email to scholarships.uowgs@gmail.com. (Available at https://blogs.uoregon.edu/uowgs/2019/04/10/2022-scholarships-open/)
- Curriculum vitae (submitted in the Google form as a PDF).

Your application will be reviewed by a panel of three to five reviewers from various scientific disciplines.

- *Awardees will be asked to provide a UO ID number to confirm your status as a student. Receipt of the award is dependent upon confirmation.
- **Those receiving the award will be required to mention its receipt in the acknowledgements section of their talk or poster.
- ***Receiving this award may change your eligibility for federal financial aid. Federal regulations require you to notify the Financial Aid Office as soon as you know you will be receiving any additional financial package so that the proper revisions can be made. Please review how the receipt of this award may affect you by contacting the Financial Aid Office before applying for this award.
